


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 18 million vaccines have been administered; 52% of the target population has received the 2nd dose.




Cases have been rising for the past few days, although they remain well below the daily peak of about 9,000 cases in mid-April-21. PCR test positivity rate remains rangebound slightly below 10%.





Although mobility restrictions have eased in recent weeks, roughly 30% of the population is still under lockdown (Paso 1, area in red). Mobility has increased at the margin, yet remains well below March-21 levels.

The health sector has been able to accommodate the rise in cases since March-21. While bed capacity remains strained, availability has increased at the margin.




COVID-19 related Deaths




ICU patients between 50-69 years of age have steadily declined in recent weeks, while the average age of ICU patients continues to fall.
