


### An Update on COVID-19 in Chile


More than 23 million vaccines have been administered, with 72% of the target population completing the process.




Chile has received more than 26 million vaccines, with supply mainly coming from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.


The fall in cases continues to support a gradual relaxation of mobility restricting measures; as of July 4<sup>st</sup>, 2021, roughly 18.4% of the nation's population will be in lockdown, down from above 50% a month ago.


#### **Nationwide Mobility**

Percent deviation with respect to pre-Covid levels




Critical bed capacity has increased this year, yet availability remains stressed.

#### **Critical beds**




#### **COVID-19 related Deaths**
