


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 15 million vaccines have been administered; 47% of the target population has received the 2nd dose.

Millions




Administered Doses per Age Group

After peaking slightly above 9,000 cases per day in April-21, COVID-19 cases have declined for several weeks, averaging roughly 5,500 cases per day. Test positivity rate has edged slightly below 10%.


COVID-19 Cases in Chile

PCR Test Positivity Rate



Although mobility restrictions have eased in recent weeks, roughly 60% of the population is still under lockdown (Paso 1, area in red). Mobility has increased at the margin, yet remains well below March-21 levels.


Share of Population per Phase



The health sector has been able to accommodate the rise in cases since March-21. While bed capacity remains strained, availability has increased at the margin.


Critical beds

COVID-19 related Deaths



ICU patients by Age Group in Chile


