## An Update on COVID-19 vaccinations in Chile

**Santiago, April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021.** The Government of Chile has made rapid progress in the COVID-19 vaccination effort. Thus far, more than 7.7 million people have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, equivalent to 50.9% of the target population. Separately, more than 5.4 million people have received a second dose, equivalent to over a third of the target population.

### Vaccinated Population as of April 17<sup>th</sup>

- Approximately 7.7 million have received the first dose of a vaccine, equivalent to approximately 50.9% of the target population.
- Roughly 5.4 million people have received the second dose, equivalent to 35.7% of the target population.

### Vaccine Doses Received

- As of April 17<sup>th</sup>, Chile has received a total of 15,559,926 doses, composed of 13,471,476 SINOVAC doses and 2,088,450 Pfizer-BioNTech doses.
- The first shipment of AstraZeneca vaccines (160,000 doses) are set to be delivered this week, as part of the 818,000 AstraZeneca doses of the COVAX Global Alliance.
- Shipments of Pfizer-BioNTech doses will continue, with roughly 285,000 doses expected to be received this week.
- Separately, 1.8 million CanSino doses are expected to be received during the second quarter of 2021.

### Agreements with Suppliers

The Government of Chile has agreements with the following suppliers:

- SINOVAC: 14.1 million doses (double dose)
- Pfizer-BioNTech: 10 million doses (double dose)
- COVAX Global Alliance: 7.6 million doses (double dose)
- AstraZeneca: up to 4 million doses (double dose)
- Johnson & Johnson: up to 4 million doses (mono dose)
- CanSino: 1.8 million doses (mono dose)


In order to ensure the herd immunity target is met by the end of the first semester of 2021, the Government continues to negotiate the purchase of additional COVID-19 vaccines.



#### Cumulative Administered Vaccines




#### Administered Doses per Age Group


#### Administered Vaccines (First Dose) by age Group & Gender




### Daily COVID-19 vaccination doses administered per 100 people, as of April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021
